

Specific Project Requirements:

Students will create a tri (3)-fold travel brochure on a destination of their choice. This destination can either be a real location or a fictitious one (i.e. Hawaii, Tahiti, Mars, Atlantis, etc.). You must include the following required elements in your project.

Use 4 of these 5 categories (the example is purposefully not correct)

1. A description of the travel destination (see example)
2. Recreational activities
3. What a traveler should bring with them
4. Travel recommendations (how to get to the destination and once there, how to get around.)
5. Travel Packages (for example 3 night, 4 night, or 7 day trips and costs).

Other requirements:

- Change the page layout to "Landscape"
- Set Margins to:

Top=0.5"	Bottom=0.5"
Right=0.5"	Left=0.5"

- 3 Columns without a line between each column (**this is not a table**)
- In the first column, press the [Enter] key a couple of times and then **insert a title**
- **DO NOT** place the colored rectangles on your document until you have written all of your information and filled up the three columns with the [required information](#), images and headings.
- Use the last 2 columns for the information about your travel destination.
 1. Make sure to include in the last 2 columns:
 2. A minimum of 3 images no larger than 2" x 2"
 3. Text size no larger than 12.
 4. A list, either bulleted or numbered.
- Then, (**DO THIS LAST**) put your colored rectangular panels behind the text that you created. Use the drawing tool to make the **rectangles** and then **right-click** on them go to **Order** to "**send them to the back**" and **send them Behind text**.

In the first column, create a front cover to your brochure. Use the drawing toolbar, images and word art to make this look interesting.
