Classroom Guidelines

- 4. Other perks up to the instructors discretion

Procedures

- 1. When the teacher raises their hand and says, "GIVE ME FIVE", students are to be quiet immediately and raise their hand as well.
- 2. Students are to enter the classroom, take their seats and begin bellwork immediately. If you are not in your seat when the bell rings you will be marked tardy.
- 3. Students will not speak when another person (teacher or called upon student) is speaking during classroom discussion or presentations.
- 4. The teacher, not the bell will dismiss the class. Instructor will say that it is time to either clean up or start saving your work a few minutes before the bell.
